
Peace educators deliver individualized attention and guidance providing multiple weekly contacts with students through one-on-one mentoring, group activities, classroom monitoring, and service projects.




The TKF Restorative Workshop is a social-emotional curriculum teaching restorative practices, peace and forgiveness to students in their classroom environment.


